

# CALL FOR PROPOSALS

## MANAGEMENT OF STREET CHILDREN WITHIN ETHEKWINI MUNICIPALITY BOUNDARIES THROUGH A GRANT-IN-AID

The Municipality's Health Unit's Social Development Department requests suitably qualified and appropriately registered Nonprofit Organisations (NPOs) to submit detailed proposals on how they would manage street children and in turn the Municipality will support successful NPOs through the Grant-in-Aid.

**The proposal must entail how the following will be undertaken:**

- Reaching out to children living on the street
- Managing a Drop-in-Centre/Shelter, which receives street children
- Re-unification with the families of origin or placement to shelters
- Further counselling or related short term rehabilitative within the Drop-in-Centre

Successful NPOs would be selected based on the following criteria:

- Located and operating in one of the 3 identified areas:
  - o North – INK area, Umhlanga, Verulam and Tongaat and surrounding areas
  - o South – Central – CBD, Overport, Bluff and Isipingo and surrounding areas
  - o West – Westville, Pinetown and Hillcrest and surrounding areas
- Minimum 5 years experience in street children programmes and projects
- Registration as NPO with Social Development Department
- Registration with Social Development Department (Province) as a Drop-in Centre or Shelter of proof of a MOU with specific shelter on referrals for accommodation
- Existing infrastructure and equipment
- Existing Human Resources
- Tax Clearance Certificate

### • **AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENT**

- Operational Plan
- Proposed budget
- Bank statement (past 3 months)

This is a short-term strategy for a 24 month period

**NB: The selection process will entail the following:**

- Interviews of the shortlisted NPOs
- Site visits to the shortlisted NPOs
